## The Most Beautiful Books - catalogues and artist books at Plan B Cluj

**Plan B Cluj** is happy to invite you to an encounter with artist books and catalogues selected in the National Book Design Competition *The Most Beautiful Books of Romania* in the last three years.

The editing of art books is an important instrument in the discourse of contemporary art, and this exhibition attempts to create a space of reflection and interaction with very diverse Romanian publications which reconsider the visual outlook of the object-book. Books about art are often difficult to publish in large editions and we hope this exhibition will contribute to passing on an in-depth understanding of the book publication process. For this reason, in January we will host a series of meetings with designers, editors and artists, within the *Learning and Unlearning* program, initiated in 2014 by Plan B Cluj in order to facilitate a dialogue between different generations of artists, in the form of workshops.

The presentation of the books will highlight their contemporary design favoring an experimental approach to visuality. The public reception of an art book largely depends on the visual suggestions transmitted by its very materiality. The space opened thereby can articulate the function of the book as an artistic product in itself and as a curating instrument.
